### Key Knowledge

Numbers	Un, deux, trois, quatre, cinq, six, sept, huit, neuf, dix.
Colours	Rouge, bleu, vert, jaune, noir, blanc, gris, violet, rose, brun.
Days of the Week	Lundi, mardi, mercredi, jeudi, vendredi, samedi, dimanche.
Months of the Year	janvier, février mars, avril, mai, juin, juillet, aout, septembre, octobre, novembre, decembre.
Seasons	Le printemps, l'été, l'automne, l'hiver.

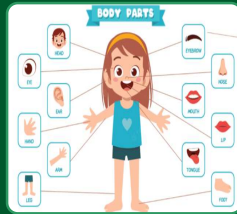
### Key Questions

- 1 Can you greet people in different ways in French?
- 2 Can you answer the question, 'what is your name?' in French?
- 3 Can you answer the question, 'how old are you?' in French?
- 4 Can you count to 10 in French?
- 5 Do you know 3 colours in French?



### Key Knowledge

- Learning numbers beyond 10
- Using months to describe when our birthday is
- Learning the names for body parts
- Learning to describe ourselves in speaking and writing (introduce the verb 'I have'). Revising colours (to describe hair and eyes).
- Learning to talk and write about pets (I have = J'ai).
- Learning to say what they like and don't like.
- Learning how to say the time in French.
- Learning to talk and write about brothers and sisters (revision of J'ai = I have).
- Learning to say where they live.
- Learning about other countries in the world who speak French.

Brothers and Sisters	J'ai un... frère, soeur, il s'appelle, elle s'appelle. J' habite.

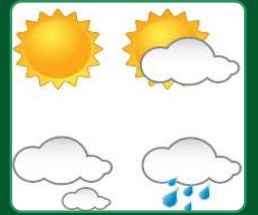
### Key Questions

- 1 Can you say when your birthday is in French?
- 2 Can you say what colour eyes and hair you have in French?
- 3 Do you know the names of 2 or more pets in French?
- 4 Can you say, 'I have/don't have a (name of pet)' in French?
- 5 Can you say, 'I have a (brother or sister)' in French?



### Key Knowledge

- Learning the names of other family members in French.
- Learning the 3 pronouns for 'my' in French (revision of masc. and fem)
- Learning to describe their family (their names, how old they are).
- Using adjectives to describe their family.
- Winter – describing a snow man.
- Learning the names of planets in French.
- Teaching ordinal numbers.
- Using colours to describe planets. Introduce opposites to describe planets - grand, petit (big and small) loin, pres, hot, cold.
- Revising numbers (how many moons does each planet have?).
- Learning to talk about where they live.
- Names of buildings.
- To use the phrase, 'il y a' (there is).
- Learning the names of School subjects in French.
- Learning to use parce-que to say why they like or don't like something (using the negative).
- Learning to talk and write about the weather.

School Subjects	Les mathematiques, l'anglais, le français, geographie, histoire, J'aime je n'aime pas, je deteste, j'adore

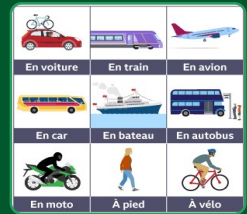
### Key Questions

### Key Knowledge

- Learning the names of food and drink in French
- Holding a simple conversation about what foods we like and don't like.
- Expressing preferences about why we like those foods.
- Being able to order a drink in French.
- Ordering a sandwich in French
- Learning about the French breakfast and carrying out a simple café role play.
- French Christmas traditions
- Learning the names of different modes of transport in French.
- Learning the verb 'to go'.
- Using adjectives with transport (eg colours, fast/slow).
- Learning to say, 'it is'.
- Learning the correct preposition to go with the vehicle.
- Learning the names of places in a town.
- Revising 'it is'.
- Revising the verb 'to go'.
- Reading, speaking and writing sports names in French.
- Holding a simple conversation in French based on sports.
- Reading and writing sentences about sports.
- Expressing preferences about sports in French.
- Saying and writing our favourite things.
- Visit from a secondary school language teacher (year 6 each year).
