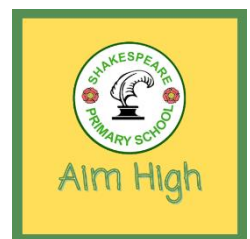
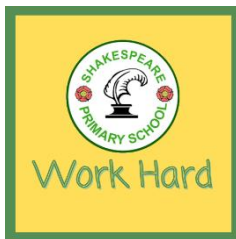
HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT
