Our school is committed to working with families to ensure the best possible outcomes for children. This includes supporting children and their families to thrive. From time to time we all go through situations which are difficult to cope with.

At these times, we need help and advice, but it is not always easy to find the right department or agency. The Early Help Offer give parents a framework for asking for support. At Shakespeare we use the Lancashire Early Help Assessment Framework to do this.

LANCASHIRE EARLY HELP ASSESSMENT

The Early Help Assessment (EHA) helps school to work in partnership with a family from a holistic and strength-based approach to gather, explore and analyse with families, information about all aspects of the child (and their family's) life. In doing so, the aim is to identify areas where change will help to meet any identified support needs and positively impact on their lived experiences.

As part of this process, Team Around the Family (TAF) meetings are held so that a wide partnership of services can provide families with the right support at the right time.




