Sports Grant Statement 2025/26 Primary

School's Sport Funding Grant = £19,580

The Government is providing further funding to provide substantial primary school sport funding. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school head teachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. This funding has been extended and will continue for the financial year 2025 – 2026. The sport funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

Key Targets during the 2025-2026 academic year

Shakespeare will be working alongside Fleetwood Town Football Club who will be providing their core and hub offer which will involve 2 afternoons a week (36 weeks of extracurricular activities). These extra-curricular clubs will be supported by a teacher or teaching assistant to enhance the sports on offer to a wider audience.

The aim is to spend the sports funding to continue to improve the following areas:

1. To further improve the quality of existing PE teaching through continuing professional development in PE for teachers, so that all their pupils improve their health, skills and physical literacy.
2. To increase participation levels in physical activity through mastering basic fundamental movement skills, increasing confidence and understanding of how to apply these skills in a range of activity areas.
3. To further increase participation in inclusion events and competitions which offer a breadth of opportunity for targeted abilities and a variety of age groups.
4. To develop sports facilities for sustainable use.
