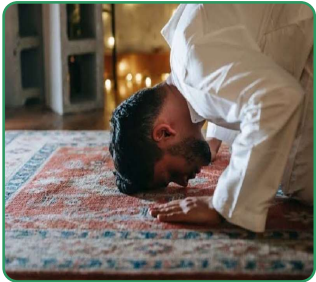

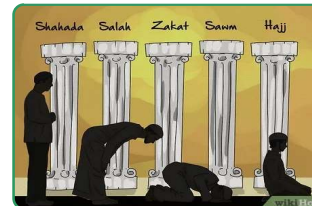

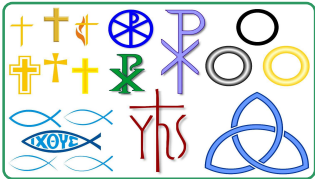

Commandments	The rules given to Moses for all Jews to follow.

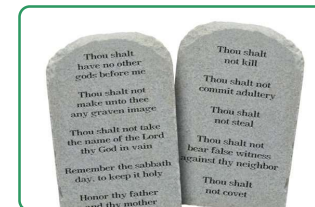
