



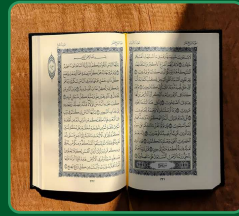
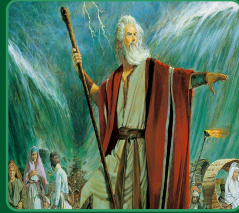
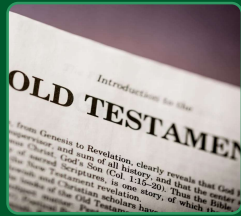
Key Knowledge, Vocabulary and Questions

Old Testament	The books in the Bible before the birth of Jesus.
Service	To give up time to help others.
Christian Vocation	To work to serve others by following the example of Jesus.
Prophet	A messenger of God.
Qur'an	The holy book for Muslims.
Pillar	Something which holds up a building
Pillars of Islam	The rules from the Qur'an which Muslims follow.

Disciple	A follower.
Volunteer	People who give up their time to help others without payment.
Holy Spirit	Christians believe it as a gift from God, that he is always with you.
Pentecost	The time when Christians remember the coming of the holy spirit.
Messiah	Believed to be sent by God to be a saviour. Christians believe that this person is Jesus.
Qualities	Qualities – what makes you who you are.

Worship	An act that shows devotion or love for God.
Raksha Bandhan	A Hindu festival which celebrates unity in families.
