Uniform Policy

Following consultation with staff and parents, the governors have adopted the following policy on school uniform:

Grey pinafore dress, skirt, trousers or shorts
White traditional school shirt
Green and yellow school tie
Green knitted cardigan, V-necked sweater or tank top, with/without logo
Green gingham/striped dress may be worn in the summer term only (After Easter)
White/grey socks or plain dark green/grey/black tights
Black school shoes (no trainers, boots, platform soles or high heels)

Grey trousers or shorts
White traditional school shirt
Green and yellow school tie
Green knitted V-necked sweater or tank top, with/without logo
Grey socks
Black school shoes (no trainers or boots, shoes must not have steel toe caps)

Blazer A green school blazer with the school logo on is an ***optional*** item.

Summer term only

If it is hot, at the Headteacher's discretion, families will be informed that ties can be removed.

Jewellery

One pair of small gold or silver coloured stud earrings and a watch may be worn but **no other jewellery** e.g. hooped earrings, bracelets or necklaces

Hair

Hair should be of a suitable style and a natural colour as determined by the head teacher and long hair (girls or boys) must always be tied back with simple hair accessories in school colours.

Shaved heads, cut patterns and Mohawk styles will not be allowed.

Make up, including nail varnish is not allowed.
