



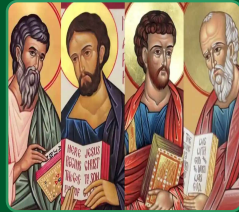
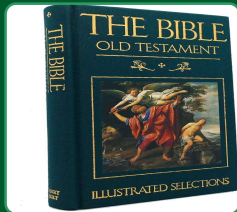
Key Knowledge, Vocabulary and Questions

Key Knowledge

- Know why the story of Rama and Sita is important to Hindus.
- Know how Hindus celebrate Diwali.
- Know how they can bring 'light' to others.



Key Vocabulary

Authority	The power or right to give orders or make decisions.
Old Testament	Books of the Bible before the birth of Jesus.
Gospels	Books of the Bible which tell the story of Jesus' life.
Diwali	The Hindu festival of light.
Avatar	Something which takes on another form E.g Hindu God can take on many forms, often human.

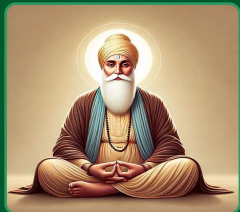
Key Knowledge, Vocabulary and Questions

Key Knowledge

- Know that the Easter story is about sacrifice.



Key Vocabulary

Community	A group of people who live or work together may support each other.
Guru	A religious teacher.
Gurdwara	A Sikh place of worship.
Equality	The idea of seeing everyone as equal.
Sacrifice	Giving something up.
Temptation	Something you want to have or to do even though you know you shouldn't.
Agape	Sacrificial love.

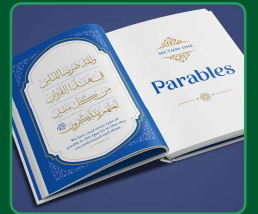
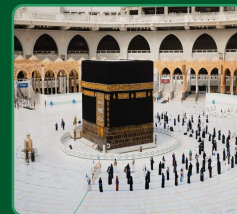
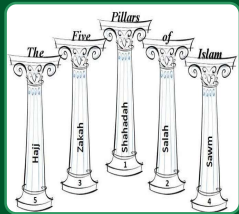
Key Knowledge, Vocabulary and Questions

Key Knowledge

- Know that Muslims have 5 rules which they are committed to.
- Know the reasons why Muslims fast.
- Know that people can learn from stories
- Know the meaning of The Good Samaritan
- Know that Jesus taught his followers to 'love' others.



Key Vocabulary

Allah	The name of God for Muslims.
Fasting	Giving up food and water for an amount of time
Ramadan	Ramadan – the month of fasting for Muslims
Shahada	Shahada – Islamic belief that there is one God and Allah is his messenger.
Salah	Prayer
Saum	Fasting during Ramadan
Zakah	The giving of a certain amount of money to charity.
Hajj	Muslims journey to Mecca at least once in their lifetime.
Agape	Selfless love
Moral	A lesson which can come from a story
Fable	A story which usually has animals in which teaches a moral lesson.
Parable	Stories which Jesus told to teach people about God and how to live their lives.
