



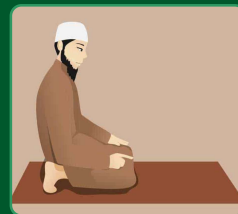
Key Knowledge, Vocabulary and Questions

Year 5

Key Knowledge

- Know the Bible story of creation.
- To understand that the Bible can be interpreted literally and metaphorically.
- To know the importance of forgiveness for Christians.
- To know that Jesus taught a prayer called the Lord's Prayer which talks about temptation and forgiveness.
- Know that for religious people their holy books are often a source of guidance.
- To know the names of holy books for some religions e.g. Muslims, Christians and Sikhs.
- To know how Muhammad 'received' the Qur'an.
- To know that Muslims treat the Qur'an with great respect.



Key Vocabulary

Sin	An action that is bad.
Temptation	A desire to do something which is against a long-term goal.
Parable	A simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson.
Confession	Saying sorry
Forgiveness	Accepting someone's apology and putting aside any bad feelings.
Interpretation	Explaining reframing or showing your own understanding of something.
Reconciliation	Bringing people together to restore friendship.
Qur'an	The holy book for Muslims.
Muhammad	The most important prophet for Muslims.
Shahada	The first pillar of Islam which states that there is only one God and Muhammad is his messenger.

Miracle	An extraordinary event taken as a sign of God.
Divine	Being God.
Incarnate	God in human form
Resurrection	Bringing someone back to life
Faith	Complete trust in something, believing in it even though you can't see it.

- 5 What is a pilgrimage and why might Christians make a pilgrimage to the Holy Land?



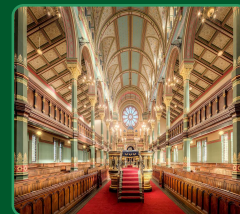
Key Knowledge, Vocabulary and Questions

Key Knowledge

- Know that stories might contain messages and symbolic language for people to learn from.
- Know that Hindu scriptures offer Hindus guidance on how to live their lives.
- Understand the significance of the Hindu festival of Holi.
- Know the story of Moses freeing the Jews from slavery.
- Know that the synagogue is the place where Jews can receive teaching from The Torah.
- Know the role of rules in guiding communities.



Key Vocabulary

Krishna	The Hindu God of compassion, protection and love.
Holi	A Hindu festival
Deity	A heavenly or divine being.
Avatar	The incarnation of a deity in human or animal form to counteract evil in the world.
Torah	The holy book for Jews
Synagogue	The place of worship for Jews.
Covenant	An agreement or promise
Rabbi	A Jewish teacher in a synagogue.
