



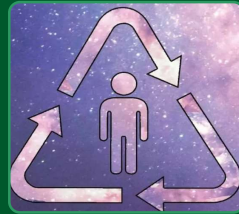
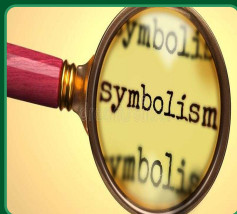
# Key Knowledge, Vocabulary and Questions

## Key Knowledge

- Know that life is punctuated by special events and commitments.
- Know the events of Jesus' baptism.
- Know that there is both infant and adult baptism.
- Know that confirmation builds on the promises made at baptism and that it shows Christian faith and commitment.
- To consider their own challenges, commitments and responsibilities they may face whilst growing up.
- Know that Hindus believe in reincarnation.



## Key Vocabulary

Baptism	A Christian ceremony in which water symbolically washes away sin and involves a public commitment to Jesus.
Sin	Doing evil or wrong things
Symbolism	Representing something in images.
Confirmation	A special church service in which a person confirms the promises made at baptism.
Reincarnation	The belief that after death comes a new life.
Samsara	The Hindu belief of the endless circle of birth, death and rebirth
Karma	The idea that good and bad actions can bring reward or punishment.
Moksha	The relief from the cycle of rebirth.
Purpose	The things which motivate in life.

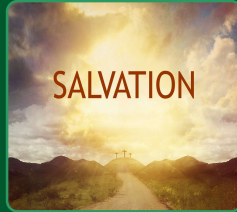
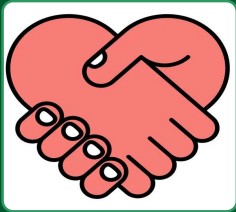
# Key Knowledge, Vocabulary and Questions

Ummah	The community of Muslims.

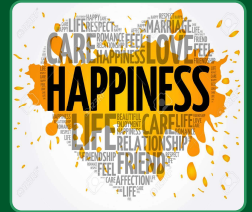
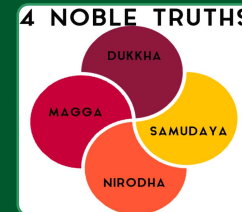
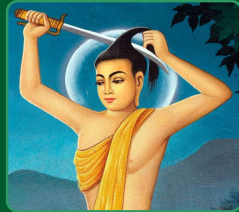
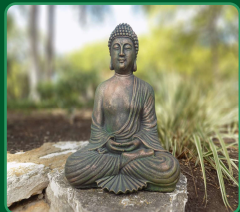
