Celebrating Harvest in Class R

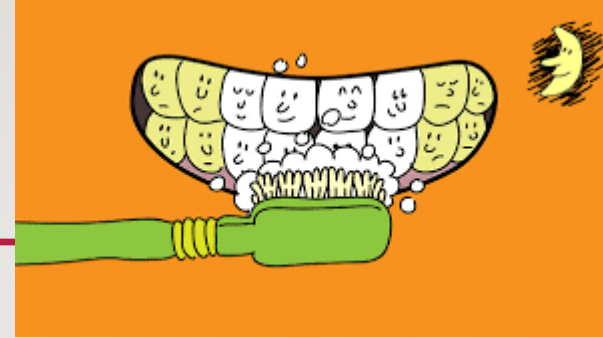
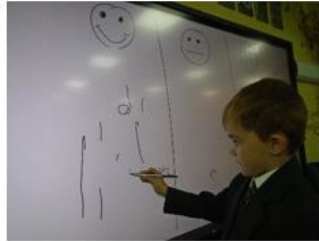


On Tuesday we found a key on the classroom carpet. We imagined who it could belong to.....

We looked at our class rules and why we need them in school. We also thought of other places we need to follow rules.

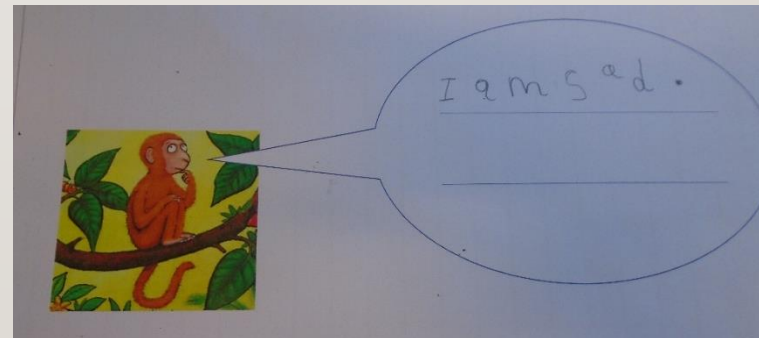
Working in a group.

In Science, we ordered a timeline and discussed how we change.

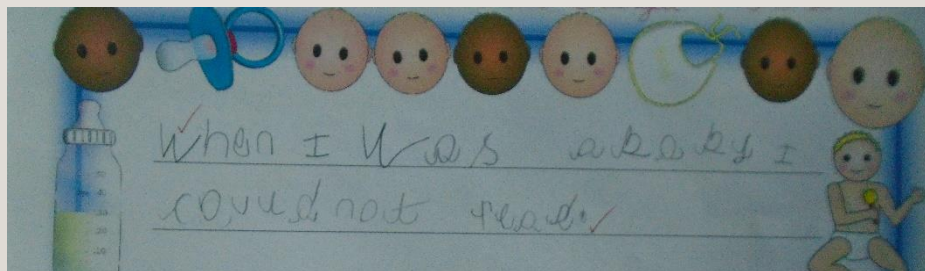


In RE, we read Joshua Wins the Day. We discussed how the characters trusted each other. We then thought about who we trusted and why.

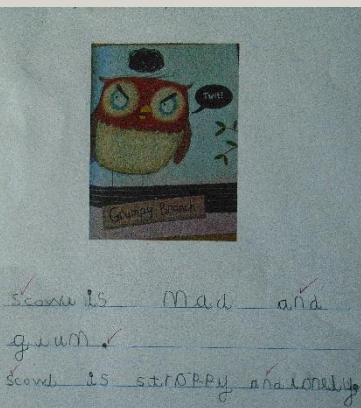

In English, we read Big Bad Owl. We discussed how Scowl's friends tried to cheer him up and how that made him feel.

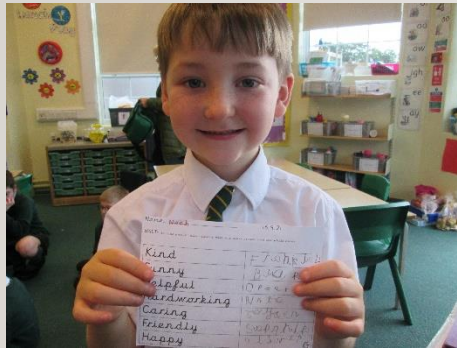
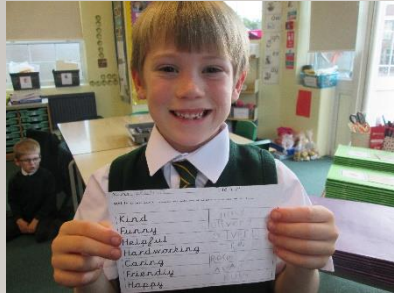


In Science, we have been thinking about how we change. We discussed what we can do now that we couldn't do when we were younger.

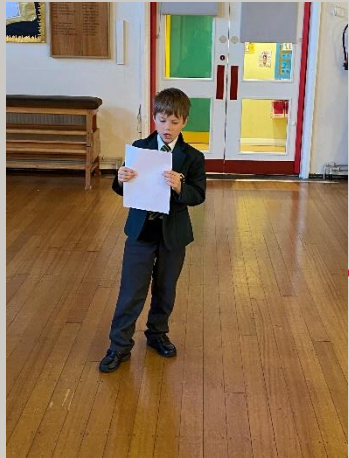

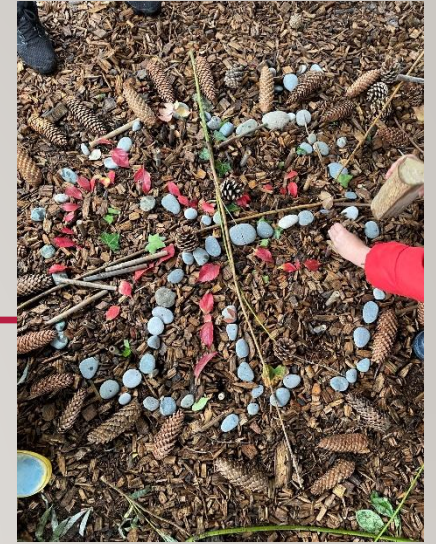
YEAR 3

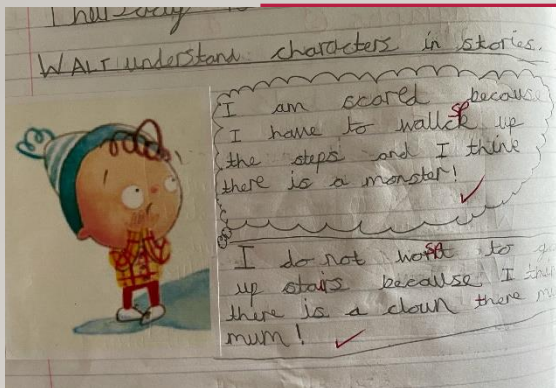


For Remembrance Day we made poppies to commemorate those who fought and died for us.

In our nature art sessions we all worked together to create mandalas.



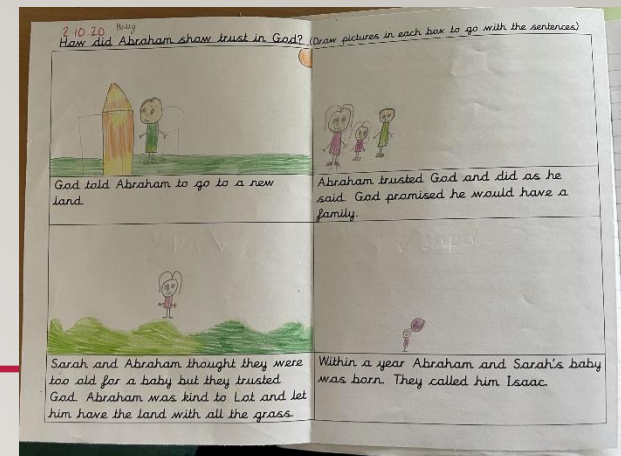
YEAR 4

In RE we learnt about trust and keeping promises.



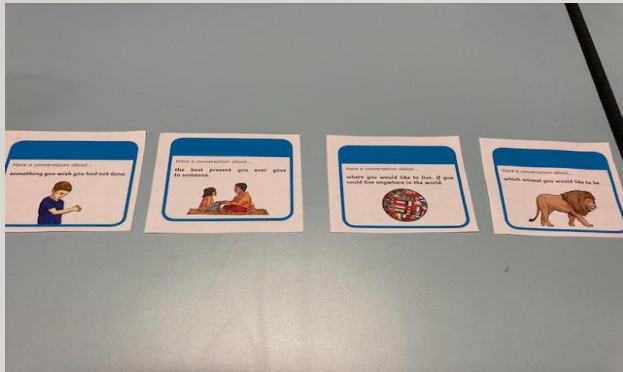
In PE lessons we have learnt about how to keep our bodies healthy.

Celebrating birthdays.



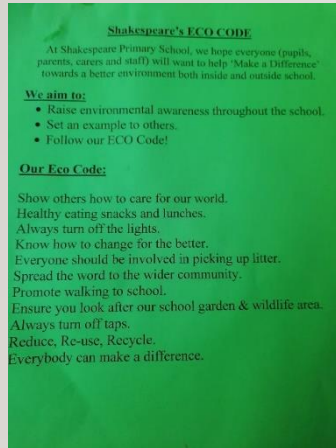
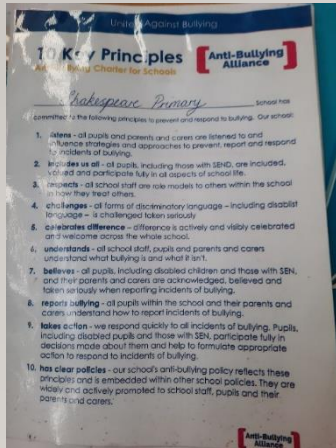
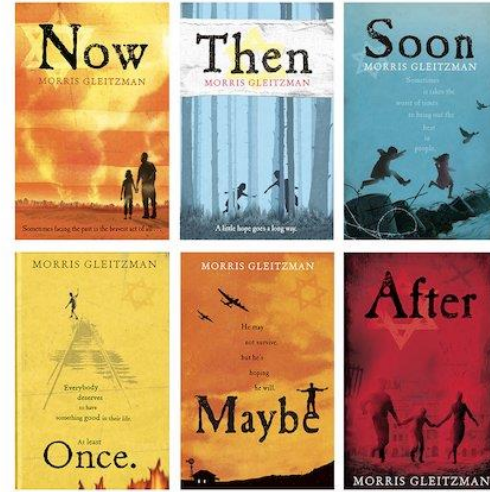
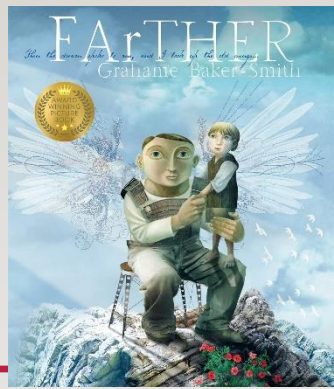
Playing social games which get us talking to each other.
