RWI DAILY PHONICS SESSIONS

Children take part in a daily Read Write Inc. session across EYFS and KS1 (this continues for some children in KS2 as required.)

- All sessions are delivered by trained staff and follow the RWI approach
- Children are grouped according to their phonic ability
- Groupings are flexible and regularly reviewed based upon ongoing assessment
- Regular robust professional development is in place for our staff using RWI hub training, coaching and the Ruth Miskin online pathway

RWI BOOSTER SESSIONS

Teachers effectively use assessment for learning alongside the RWI tracker to identify children who require further support. Children who are making slower progress in their reading and need extra daily practise in reading sounds and words will require overlearning to secure their phonics knowledge:

- Whole-class 'Phonics Blast' - Speed Sound Consolidation
- QR Code Phonics Games
- Pinny Time/Fred Games

PHONIC INTERVENTIONS

Alongside RWI booster sessions, we use a range additional resources and targetted interventions to support children who require an adaptive approach or further overlearning:

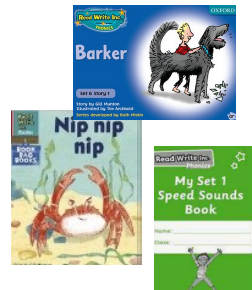
- RWI Virtual Classroom Teaching Videos
- RWI one-to-one Tuition Sessions (Practice Activities)
- Precision teaching (Sounds or CEW/RWI red words)
- Small Group Consolidation Sessions
- Additional Pinny Time-Speed Sound Practise
- 1:1 Reading using RWI books

WEEKLY HOME READING

As part of home reading, the children take home the following books each week:

- **RWI Book** - This is the book that they have read in their RWI session to build fluency.
- **RWI Book Bag Book** - This is a decodable text closely matched to their phonic ability.
- **Book from our Banded Scheme**- This is correlated to the corresponding RWI stage and can be read with an adult.
- **Book for Pleasure**- All children choose a reading for pleasure book to share with their parents.

HOW ELSE DO WE SUPPORT PHONICS AT HOME?

Teachers provide additional resources to engage and support parents with helping their child to practise phonics at home.

- RWI teaching videos
- QR Code linked to interactive phonics games
- Sounds and CEW flashcards/packs

Parents are invited into school regularly to take part in phonic sessions/activities and workshops.
